HOW TO REQUEST OUR ITEMS

General Policies

- ◆ Materials check out for 4 weeks
- ◆ You may check out up to 5 items at a time
- ◆ You may renew items twice (as long as there is not another request for that item)

Our library materials are free for you to borrow.

We encourage EI Clearinghouse library patrons to use their local public library to request our materials. However, you don't need to be a member of a library, but you must live in Illinois.

You can order items through our online request form or call us. Whether you have a general topic you'd like information on or a specific book or DVD title, we can assist you.

We will mail them to you or send them through your local public library for pickup.

You simply return them to us through your local public library. Each item borrowed will include a library routing slip to facilitate return of the material.

Many resources are available in Spanish as well as English.

EARLY INTERVENTION

WHAT IS THE EI PROGRAM?

The Early Intervention (EI) Program provides services to help your child grow and learn during the first 3 years of life. It serves families of children from birth to age 3 who have developmental delays or disabilities or who are at risk for developmental delays.

WHY IS EI IMPORTANT?

During the first 3 years of life, children's brains and bodies are growing rapidly. They are learning many new things about the world around them. While all children need love and support to grow and learn, some children need a little extra help. With the right help, your child can reach his/her potential.
